Introduction

At The Parks Pre-Primary, we believe that a positive partnership between parents and educators is essential for the development and well-being of all children. This Code of Conduct outlines the expectations for parents to create a nurturing and respectful environment for our children.

1. Respect and Support

- Treat all staff, children, and other parents with kindness and respect.
- Support the school's mission and values by promoting a positive atmosphere.

2. Communication

- Maintain open and honest communication with teachers and staff.
- Share any concerns or feedback in a constructive manner.
- Attend parent-teacher meetings and school events to stay engaged.

3. Role Modelling

- Exhibit positive behaviour that reflects the values we teach the children.
- Encourage your child to respect others, share, and be kind.

4. Safety and Health

- Ensure your child is healthy and fit to attend school; keep them home if they are unwell.
- Inform staff of any allergies or medical conditions your child may have.
- Follow all safety protocols and guidelines set by The Parks Pre-Primary.

5. Attendance and Punctuality

- Ensure your child attends school regularly and arrives on time.
- Inform the school of any absences in advance whenever possible.

6. Participation

- Get involved in school activities, volunteering, and supporting fundraising efforts.
- Offer your time and skills to enhance the nursery school experience for your child.

7. Conflict Resolution

- Address any issues or conflicts directly with the staff in a respectful manner.
- Avoid discussing grievances with other parents before bringing concerns to the school; gossiping or sharing unverified information can harm the school's reputation and create unnecessary tension.
- Use appropriate channels for resolving disputes, avoiding confrontations in front of children.

8. Confidentiality

- Respect the privacy of other families and children; do not share personal information without consent.
- Maintain confidentiality regarding any sensitive issues discussed at the school.

9. Compliance with Rules

- Adhere to all school policies, rules, and procedures.
